RESOLUTION NO. 14 - 2021

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF JESSUP, LACKAWANNA
COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, FIXING THE VARIOUS BOROUGH TAX AND
REFUSE REMOVAL RATES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR OF 2022
AND ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022
AS PRESENTED**

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Jessup Borough Council, as follows:

SECTION ONE:

A “Local Services Tax” at the rate of tax of fifty-two (\$52.00) dollars per person or persons engaged in gainful employment within the Borough of Jessup, is hereby imposed for the fiscal year 2022, pursuant to the “Local Services Tax Ordinance of 2007”, as amended.

SECTION TWO:

A Wage Tax of one-half percent (1/2%) on the earned income of all residents of the Borough of Jessup is hereby imposed for the fiscal year 2022, pursuant to the Wage Tax Ordinance originally adopted April 23, 1948, as amended.

SECTION THREE:

A one percent (1%) tax on the value of transfers of real estate within the Borough of Jessup is hereby imposed for the fiscal year 2022, pursuant to the Real Estate Transfer Tax Ordinance, originally adopted December 2, 1966, as amended.

SECTION FOUR:

A tax will be, and the same is hereby levied upon real property situate within the Borough of Jessup which is subject to taxations for Borough purposes for the fiscal year 2022 as follows:

The real estate tax rate for general Borough purposes is the sum of Twenty-One and Seven-Tenths (21.7) mills.

SECTION FIVE:

The residential fee for the collection and disposal of refuse within the Borough of Jessup, formally adopted as Ordinance No. 4 of 1980, and as subsequently amended, is hereby enacted for the fiscal year 2022 at the rate of \$35.00 per dwelling unit per year and the fee for

commercial non-manufacturing (professional uses) shall be \$50.00 per year and commercial light manufacturing shall be \$75.00 per year. All remaining terms and conditions to remain as stated.

SECTION SIX:

The proposed tentative Borough budget for fiscal year 2022, as advertised and approved, is hereby enacted, adopted and ordained in its entirety as the official budget for the year 2022.
