Old Business:

Winton Storm Water

- Winthrop - KBA settled on the path from option 1. This option requires easement from only 1 landowner. KBA is now working with the survey maps and easements. We can start looking into grants using the list that was used for the Ward street project.
- Calomino/Nenish swale – Letters went out to property owners and work should start week of 10/18.

Ward Street

- We need a work plan and schedule by 10/15 noon. If it is not delivered by then, we will look to change the contractor.
- John will inform them the PennDot approved pipe needs to be used.

Blakely Street to Sterry Creek – Tony looked at the plans for this line. We are working with Sandy Opshinsky to apply for a 100% Hazard Mitigation Plan grant. Project cost is approx. \$570,000

1st Avenue (LaSalle Academy)

- The project is being added to the budget but the priority is low so it probably will not get done till 2023.

Church Street

- John needs to study the plan more but we should budget approx. \$350,000 for grant purposes. If we do not get a grant, this will most likely be a 2023 project.

Misc.

- Attorney Karpowich is looking into the ability to do a negative storm water impact on qualifying new development projects.

New Business

- A recommendation was made to have the storm water and Park/Rec committee meetings on the same evening in 2022– 2nd Wed of month – Storm water at 6:00 and Parks/Rec at 7:00.
- Rella discussed the storm water pamphlet that she received from Lancaster County. We can use them as handout and also add the PDF to the website.
- Angela Requested the opportunity to present the storm water module at an upcoming council meeting or work session (possibly December)
