Motion to accept April 2022 Minutes - Made by Angela Muchal - Seconded by Roberta Galati. All in favor.

Minutes

- Reviewed all active project
 1. Bridge Street – Waiting on drilling company for the gas and water location survey. It is tentatively scheduled for June 20 if Mia is able to get the retainer to them.
 2. Blakely/Lane streets (PEMA/FEMA project) – Hazard Mitigation letter is required. It was sent to Mia on May 24. Need an amendment to the Lackawanna County mitigation. We have no timeframe at this time.
 3. Engineer is reaching out tot the PEMA contact for a status. No deadlines are established at this point.
 4. Church Street – The engineer determine that there is no need to increase the storm waterline size on Front Street at this time.
 5. Winthrop – Plan modifications and cot updates are being made for the inclusion of storm drains on Filbert Street. The plan was sent for grant evaluation. There was no quorum for the May 24 meeting. No follow-up date was communicated yet.
 6. MS4/PRP Plan- a copy of the plan was sent to us for review. The most cost effective activity was the retro-fitting of storm drains. We have a list of 46 storm drains to select from. We need to achieve 40,000 lbs. in reduction

New Business

- Walsh Street – Engineer can't find a rental place to rent a pump. They are recommending we purchase the pump. Mia has since located a provider in Binghamton.
- A rain garden at the Heritage center site would decrease about 500 lbs. of sediment.
- The Storm Water module was presented at Valley View High School and the May Clean Air fair in Archbald. They should go on the MS4 Report.
- Ward Street Project – The contractor is nearing his time limit for the project. July 5 + rain days. After that there is a \$200/day fine. The project is about 33% done.
