**Minutes**

- Reviewed all active projects
  1. 813 Lawler Dr- (Paris Ligi) Denny visited the site. He has a few ideas for a potential fix. He will need to visit the site again during a rain event. (not sure if Paris was aware of visit)
  2. Ward Street – Walkthrough took place. No work done at the time. However, the punch list has since been started and the contractor has 30 days to complete it.
  3. Bridge Street – The Erosion and Sediment plan was submit, as was the Chapter 105 permit. A date is needed to bid the project.
  4. Winthrop Street – Survey work was submitted and plans are being finalized. Waiting to hear on the results of the final grant that was applied for.
  5. Ferdinand Street – Submitted grant application for \$355,432 – **No update**
  6. Blakely/Lane Streets (PEMA/FEMA project) – Survey is complete. Working on AutoCAD designs. **No update**
  7. Olga Street – The design is complete, but the plan will not be completed until after funding is approved. **No Update**
  8. MS4/PRP Plan- PA DEP requested a resubmittal, which was done. We have not received a response. We will roll everything into the 2023 plan
  9. MaryJo Drive – This is a sanitary sewer project. **No Update**
  10. The seven addition projects discussed between Mia and Denny are ongoing nuisance projects. The highest priority one is Rt 247 and Memorial Dr.  
**Denny will add a priority factor to the projects.**
  11. The Walsh Street pump estimate is \$73,000. We need to research flood mitigation grants
  12. Grassy Island Ave & Sand – Design was started for the fix
  13. 4<sup>th</sup> and Sturges – Sewer issues added to the list for Denny to assess

**New Business**

- Mr. Paul Skarboski discussed Storm water issues by his property on Brennan St. There are no storm drains and 2 ft pools of water form. 15 years ago the borough created a tactical fix of a ditch and hole, but it has been filled in. The land behind his property drains into this area. Denny needs to create a short-term and a strategic plan
