- Reviewed all active projects
 - 1. <u>Ward Street</u> Paving is complete. Chris is working with the bonding company.
 - 2. Blakely/Lane Streets (PEMA/FEMA project) No update.
 - 3. <u>Bridge Street</u> Awarded to the low bidder. Notice to proceed was not yet given because all contractor submittals have not yet been received.
 - 4. <u>Winton Pump Stations</u> Project not yet started because the pumps are sill on back order.
 - 5. <u>4th and Sturges</u> No update Denny provided estimates for the borough. Sandi is preparing the LSA grant.
 - 6. MS4/PRP Plan- the 2023 plan was submitted.
 - 7. <u>Veterans Drive</u> The inlet was located and cleaned out. Pavement was repaired. Periodic cleaning will need to be scheduled.
 - 8. <u>Sand St and Grassy Island Ave</u> The project was started but put on temporary hold. A gas line was found to be too high and the gas company will be on site within 2 weeks. The site has been secured in the meantime.
 - 9. <u>813 Lawler Dr.</u>– (Paris Ligi) No easement was found, but Denny is continuing to develop a cost effective plan.
 - 10. <u>Second and Hands Streets (sewer)</u> No update This project will be combined with the Sturges Street project and a grant application will be submitted. The combined costs is \$548,000.
 - 11. <u>1st Ave. (Holy Ghost)</u> Awarded to Linde Corp. awaiting contractor submittals.
 - 12. <u>Sunset and Grassy Island Ave</u>. No update. Would like to treat as a change order to n current project
 - 13. Winthrop Street . An outfall submission was submitted awaiting feedback.
 - 14. JYSA Drainage Awarded to Linde Corp. in progress
 - 15. <u>Misc Inlet repairs</u> Not all inlets need to be prepared. Some just need cleaning. Deny will create an itemized list.
 - 16. <u>Brennan Street</u> Plans sent to the developer for feedback and approval. Still need a short-term fix designed. The long-term plan includes a project encompassing Brennan Street McDermott Street and Hill Street.
 - 17. 7 Misc Projects We need the projects prioritized
 - 18. <u>Hill and Constitution</u> No update Needs to be raised on the priority list. Emily thinks it might be able to be combined into a project including other streets (i.e. Brennan St & Olga St)
 - 19. <u>Ferdinand Street</u> No Update Engineer is finishing the design and permit process. Attorney Chris Szewczyk will need to work on the easements

- 20. <u>Olga Street</u> No Update The design is complete, but the plan will not be completed until after funding is approved.
- 21. MaryJo Drive No Update This is a sanitary sewer project.
- 22. <u>Walsh Street Pump Station</u> No Update Estimate is \$73,000. We need to research flood mitigation grants.
